Air-Scent International has a long track record of Air-Scent fan freshener products, which have been marketed successfully since 1946 – the longest of any similar products in the world. This proven track record includes an excellent product safety record with minimal incidents over these many years.

Most Air-Scent products conform to newly established regulations limiting volatile organic compounds (V.O.C.'s). In fact, Air-Scent was one of only thirteen companies to serve on the "NY DEC 235" Steering Committee, which was called upon to develop a draft protocol for reducing ozone-depleting substances in consumer products sold in New York State. This protocol became the standard after which the V.O.C. regulations for California (CARB, i.e., California Air Resources Board) were developed. Air-Scent products are properly registered in all states where such registration is required.

Air-Scent fan freshener refills contain no formaldehyde or known carcinogens. They contain the finest essential oils and aromatic ingredients. Many of these ingredients are of the type used directly or indirectly in food products, cosmetics and fine perfumes. They are considered "GRAS" (generally regarded as safe). The petroleum distillate diluent carriers used in some Air-Scent products has been classified by the U.S. FDA as an acceptable food contact substance. All Air-Scent fan freshener refill products have been approved by the USDA.
